Nippon Connection is the largest showcase of Japanese film in Europe, taking place annually in April in Frankfurt am Main, Germany. In 2007, over 150 films were shown, with an audience of over 16.000 attending, and 40 guests from Japan presenting their films.

The Program is divided into three parts: Nippon Cinema (for 35mm and 16mm films), Nippon Digital (for digital productions) and Nippon Retro (retrospective).

In addition to the screenings in Frankfurt, Nippon Connection Film Festival On Tour presents a selection of the program in various countries all over the World.

"Nippon Cinema Award" Competition

Since 2005, a competition in the Nippon Cinema section takes place. Every German, European or International premiere takes part in the competition. The audience determines the recipient of the "Nippon Cinema Award".

Film entries

All films must have English or German subtitles or be dubbed in German or English to be screened at the festival. For the selection process, VHS tapes or DVDs without subtitles are no problem.

The screening formats for Nippon Digital are: Digibeta, Betacam SP, miniDV, DV, DVcam and DVD. Both NTSC and PAL are possible.

Submission deadline: 18th January, 2008

There is no entry fee. The VHS or DVD sent for selection will not be returned.

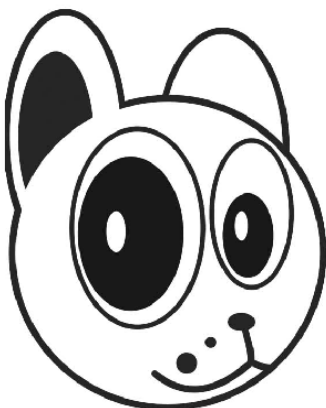
