Nippon Connection is the largest showcase of Japanese film outside of Japan, and takes place annually in April in Frankfurt/Main, Germany. In 2009 the festival showed almost 150 films, with an audience of over 16,000 attending, and 28 guests from Japan attended to present their films. The film program is divided into three parts: Nippon Cinema, Nippon Digital and Nippon Retro. In addition to the screenings in Frankfurt, Nippon Connection Film Festival On Tour presents a selection of the Nippon Digital program in various countries all over the World.

**»Nippon Cinema Award« Competition**

All films which have their German, European, International or World Premiere at Nippon Cinema are in competition for the Nippon Cinema Award, endowed with EUR 2.000. The award winner is determined by audience vote. The award ceremony will be held on April 18, 2010.

**Film entries**

---

All films must have English or German subtitles or be dubbed in German or English to be screened at the festival. For the selection process, screeners without subtitles are allowed. Accepted screening formats are: 35mm, 16mm, 8mm, HDcam, DigitalBetacam, Betacam SP, miniDV, DV, DVcam and DVD (video formats NTSC or PAL).

The screening print or tape should be sent to Nippon Connection by April 5, 2010.

Detailed transport information will be provided in time. The festival covers the costs for the film insurance according to the worth of the copy, starting with the arrival in Frankfurt until returning it to transport services.
