Accepted screening formats are: 35mm, 16mm, 8mm, HDcam, DigitalBetacam, Betacam SP, miniDV, DV, DVcam and DVD (video formats NTSC or PAL).

All material sent by mail from non-EU member states must be clearly marked with a customs declaration stating the following: »For cultural purpose only. No commercial value. No pornographic material.« It must also be accompanied by an invoice stating a value of no more than 15 USD.

If selected

You will receive notice by March 8, 2010 at the latest.

The screening print or tape should be sent to Nippon Connection by April 5, 2010. Detailed transport information will be provided in time. The festival covers the costs for the film insurance according to the worth of the copy, starting with the arrival in Frankfurt until returning it to transport services.
