11th Japanese Film Festival in Frankfurt am Main April 27-May 1, 2011

Nippon Connection is launching into its second decade: Japanese film and culture will come to Frankfurt for the eleventh time, though next year a little later than usual. From April 27 to May 1, 2011, the Hessian metropolis will turn into a land of the rising sun, when the biggest festival of Japanese film will once more present an up-to-date overview of both feature and short films – ranging from popular blockbusters to exciting documentaries and digital avant-garde films. More than 150 films will provide a treat for every cinematic taste.

Next to the programmes of NIPPON CINEMA and NIPPON RETRO, a new section will arise the following year: NIPPON DIGITAL will become NIPPON VISIONS. Given the variety of new visual modes of expression – from mobile phone videos to interactive video installations – NIPPON VISION will transcend formal barriers and test new forms of presentation. This new section will give a forum to the innovative works of talented newcomers leaving the trod-den paths, finding new forms of visual narration and showing a way into the future.

In 2010, more than 16,000 visitors from all around the world found their way to the Nippon Connection Festival. Regardless of a growing response and its international prestige, the festival is still being organised on a voluntary basis by the registered non-profit association Nippon Connection.
